The recital is approaching quickly. The following information is to inform you of some of the specifics involved. Please read all the information carefully and keep for reference as questions may come up. It is important information and plays a large role in adding to the organization and success of the recital. Please don't hesitate to call or email me with any questions you may have along the way. As a reminder:

Monday and Tuesday classes dance in the 1pm Recital.
Wednesday and Thursday classes dance in the 5pm Recital.

TUITION – Tuition is due through the month of May. All tuition should be brought current and paid no later than May 14th. All tuition, costume payments, and any other dues must be paid prior to participate in the recital. Please call me in advance if you need to make payment arrangements.

RECITAL – The recitals will be held Saturday May 16th at Kaufman Auditorium. All students will need to arrive a half hour prior to show time. It is very important that students come prepared and ready to perform. Costumes should be fully and properly worn. This includes shoes, tights, and hairpieces. Make up should be worn and hair needs to be pulled away from the face. You may do makeup and hair as you like, but please remember that you are performing in a show. Lights make it hard to see a face without make-up and hair can hide the cutest faces. **All students should arrive at the outside cafeteria entrance. Students will be dismissed to one parent in the cafeteria after the show.**

DRESS REHEARSAL – Will be held Friday May 15th at Kaufman Auditorium. This is the only mandatory rehearsal. Monday and Tuesday students will have rehearsal from 5:00-6:30pm. Wednesday and Thursday students will have rehearsal from 7:00-8:30pm. **All students should arrive and be picked up from the FRONT STREET KAUFMAN ENTRANCE.**

RECITAL PRACTICES – The last day of regular classes is Sunday May 3rd. We will then practice in our show clusters for two weeks as we prepare our orders for each show. If you have any questions regarding practice, please notify me. It is important that all students attend these practices. Please notify me if a student is unable to attend any recital practices. Recital practices are scheduled as follows: Refer to calendar for what days to attend. **Please plan to Drop Off and Pick Up students at the main studio entrance.**

Monday and Wednesday May 4th -6th
6:00 - 7:30pm

Monday and Wednesday May 11th – 13th
6:00 – 7:30pm

Monday and Tuesday students attend on Mondays
Wednesday and Thursday students attend on Wednesdays

BACKSTAGE – Only students performing in the show and assigned helpers will be admitted back stage before and during the show. Teachers will be at the entrance to take your child to the appropriate area. Supervisors and helpers will be the only people backstage. Students must remain backstage until curtain call is done at the conclusion of the show.

PICTURES – Bill Schumann will be doing the recital pictures this year. Pictures are scheduled for Thursday May 7th. Please bring your picture form with you when you come for your picture. Pictures are held at the dance studio. If you are planning to have pictures done you will need to reserve a time slot for your pictures online at signupgenius.com. Time slots run every half hour from 4pm to 7pm. Offered again this year – digital download available!

TICKETS – Recital tickets will be sold thru NMU ticketing this season to provide advanced seating. Any person attending the recital, including parents, will require a ticket. Tickets for the recital are \$15.00 per person. Tickets can be purchased beginning April 1st. Kaufman charges a mandatory \$1.25 fee per patron for a capital improvement fee. There is also a convenience fee per ticket thru NMU in order to offer reserved seating. You will see these fees reflected on your ticket total when checking out.

SHOES AND TIGHTS – The studio offers tights for \$5 for the recital. All shoes and tights needed for the recital can be purchased online or at Second Skin Shop. Tights (if needed) should be beige in color and regular not shimmery. Refer to our attire page on our website for links to both.

FALL REGISTRATION 2026 – Continuing students please remember that registration for fall classes is set up ahead of time. Students are encouraged to pre register for classes. Schedules are posted in google classroom and on our website. Please use our online registration form to register. We do early registration for continuing students because of the fact that it has been increasingly difficult to ideally set up classes according to levels and class sizes without pre-registration. I have left plenty of room for changes and add on before the fall schedule is finalized. This lets me ensure I can cover your needs as you make me aware of them. Parents can register by filling out the attached registration form or filling out the online registration on our website. It is very important to me that students have the most ideal class possible. Please be advised that students are not enrolled for fall classes until I have received the registration. Schedule is subject to change pending registration. We have really enjoyed all the students this year and hope to see everyone back next fall.

SUMMER WORKSHOPS – We are planning to hold only a couple of summer workshops in both dance and gymnastics. The summer schedule will be posted June 1st.
